

ThimbleCreek Quilt Shop Free Pattern

Halloween Treats

Approximately 57" x 57"

I love dots! And I love Halloween! Put them together and you have Halloween Treats!
Don't be too concerned about coordinating your colors-it should be scrappy and fun!!
Have fun making this quilt! It'll brighten your home!

Fabric Requirements

(9)	1/4 yd cuts	Strips & circles in border
(10)	1/8 yd cuts	Strips
(2)	1/4 yd cuts	Inner Border
(2)	1/2 yd cuts	Outer Border
	1/2 yd	Binding
	3-3/4 yd	Backing

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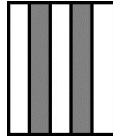
Halloween Treats

Cut the 1/8th yard pieces into 2" strips. Each 1/8th yard will give you 2 - 2" strips. Cut the 2" strips into 8" segments. This will yield 180 - 2" x 8" strips of fabric.

Piece five segments together to make a block 8" x 8" (7 1/2" x 7 1/2" finished size). Make a total of 36 blocks.



Assemble the blocks into six rows of six blocks.

Cut the inner border fabrics into 2 1/2" strips and sew to the sides and top of the quilt top. Use one fabric for top and bottom and the other fabric for the sides.

Cut the outer border fabrics into 5 1/2" strips and sew to the sides and top of the quilt. Use one fabric for top and bottom and the other fabric for the sides.

Use a CD to make your own template. Trace the CD onto template plastic. Use your favorite appliqué method for the circles. I used Wonder Under and the buttonhole stitch. Place the circles randomly around the border. It is ok to color outside of the lines! Let some of the circles overlap onto the quilt top!



Layer, baste and quilt! You did it!
